## What We Have Accomplished in N.Y.

- Brentwood NY High School District opened its doors to us with approximately 10,000 students to carry out some of our youth programs to reduce crime, drugs, gangs, graffiti, and harassment among the Young.
- According to the city's police department, crime dropped to more than 42% during this time, and it was the year where more students were able to graduate from high school.

- ▶ Set up a technical training center where we can work together with national government organizations, civil/private society, existing foundations, and international cooperation such as the one that our foundation will provide.
- ▶ Promote simple and affordable technological innovations.

Maintain their customs through oral tradition and coexistence in the community, maintain their values and ethical principles, and maintain the knowledge that is not part of the formal-basic education and part of their identity.

# OUR GOALS

- ▶ These programs aim to strengthen the rural population in their territories, thus preventing them from migrating to the big cities where they develop other low-paying jobs. It is worth noting that there are worrying indexes in this sector since only 1% of university income corresponds to young people from the countryside.
- ▶ Create the family farming program to support economic growth through comprehensive sustainable production projects, facilitate access to goods and services provided by the state.
- ▶ Promote teaching in homes, where they can occupy small spaces to produce vegetables, and fruits that help families reduce food expenses by being able to satisfy their own consumption.

## Ramon Jaquez Biography

- ▶ Born on May 12, 1972 in Inoa (Los Platanitos), Dominican Republic. The son of Gilberto and María Jaquez. Ramón is the 15th child of 17 siblings from father and mother plus he has seven more siblings from his father side.
- ▶ Since he was a child, he dedicated himself to agriculture in his hometown (los platanitos). He then took his first steps as a businessman at just the age of nine years old with his boot shine business.
- ▶ At age twelve, his mother brought the family to Brooklyn, NY. Ramón starts working in a winery. The owner, seeing his capacity, promoted him as the supervisor of that area. This young man worked hard, studied, and on weekends he worked in his brother-in-law's restaurant. When he was seventeen years old, he opened a restaurant in Manhattan at 145 and San Nicolás, called "Romana Fried Chicken." Ramón sells the restaurant and invests this money to open a meat distribution at Home Point.

- ▶ Raymond's improvement and accomplishments have always gone hand in hand with his desire to help others build a better society. His priorities have always been working with young people and their families without discriminating sex, color, race, or religion. For these reasons, he works with the Love Without Barriers JCL Foundation supporting thirty-two free-of-charge community programs available to low-income families.
